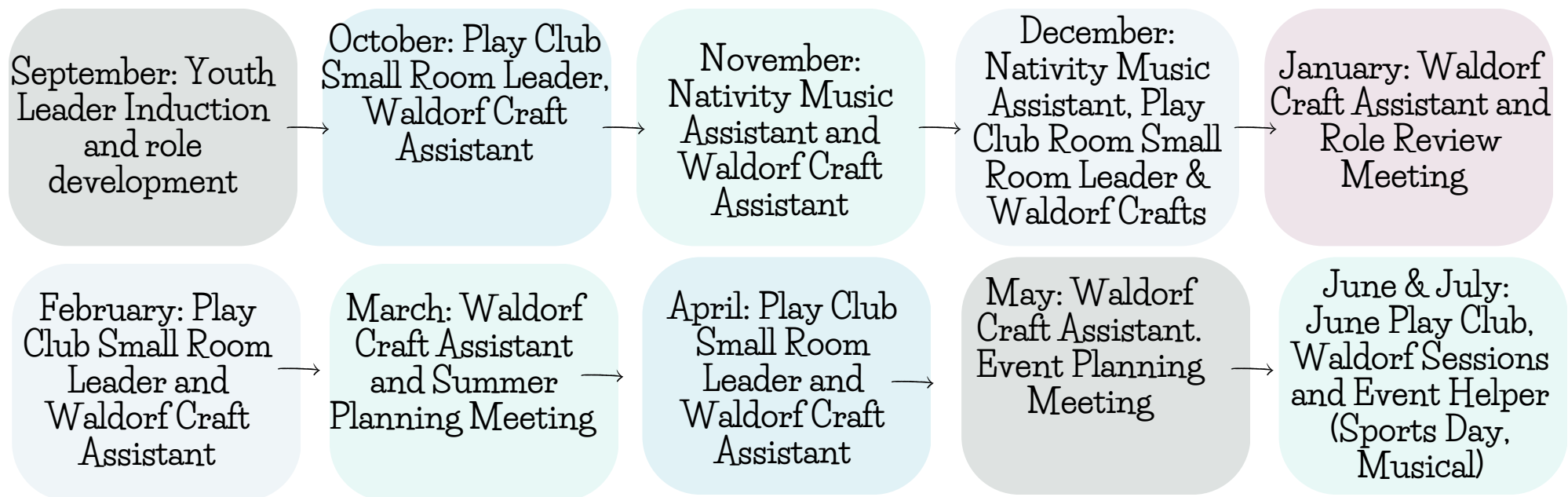




Role Proposal Example for 16-18 Youth Leaders

Role Breakdown Example

Play Club Small Room Leader: Play runs at Merryoaks every other month for children aged 3-10. We have a small room for children that want a quieter space. At the moment, this has Lego and colouring and occasionally a simple craft available. The Small Room Leader would ensure all children are able to access the materials and provide a one to one support for any that need help joining in with the games in the bigger room. 2nd Tues 1-3pm

Waldorf Craft Assistant: The younger children at Waldorf often require parental assistance to complete the craft at the end of the session. If Anna was able to come for the last hour to assist Anthea and the children with the craft, that would be very helpful. 2nd Thursdays 11:30-12:30

Nativity Music Assistant: We will be holding our second annual Nativity again this year. This year there is a lot of music to learn and it will be helpful for Anna to run some vocal warm up games with them while I am managing rehearsal logistics. She can also take small groups to learn the songs and help any children run lines. Rehearsals are in the afternoons 8th Nov, 22nd Nov, 28th Nov, 6th Dec and the dress rehearsal/performance date are TBC

Events Helper: We will have a number of events this school year that would benefit from Anna's assistance. The Nativity as detailed above and also our first Home Ed Musical and first annual Sports day, both planned for July 2025 with dates TBC. An extra pair of hands on these days would be very beneficial.
